The Okasa Kasamatsu ("Big Umbrella Pine"), also known as the Chiyo-no Kasamatsu ("The Age-Old Umbrella Pine") is a single pine which branches out like a huge umbrella, with a diameter of 15 meters (50 feet), thought to be over 630 years old.



Kanchoro
The oldest remaining tea room in Japan, built in the late Edo period. The design includes a mezzanine floor and hip-and-gable roof.
